TRIPYR ACTIONS IN FAVOR OF SUSTAINABLE TERRITORIAL DEVELOPMENT

The inter-regional European TRIPyr project focuses on the improvement of the quality of the Pyrenean environment by boosting the management and transformation of industrial wastes through circular economy strategies, while facilitating general public's access to the research advances.

From Newsletter n°2, focused on the academic research partners committed to develop new eco-catalytic processes for waste upgrading, we are continuing our series of presentations of the TRIPyr members. It's time to introduce you SAPOVAL and ECOCENE, and their specific roles in this project.

Action: Innovative approaches for the waste management

SAPOVAL (Albi, France) is a company with expertise in the study and implementation of innovative technologies for wastewater treatment and waste management. In the frame of the TRIPyr project, its mission is to target different fatty waste, to pre-treat them and provide the raw materials to the Consortium to investigate and develop waste valorization processes. Furthermore, SAPOVAL conducts fatty waste management market research, as well as that on the potential value-added products. Hence, the SAPOVAL's challenge is to develop a new fatty waste recovery sector and perform the opportunity study of its integration in the Pyrenean regional landscape.

Action: Communication and scientific dissemination

ECOCENE (Pau, France) is an association close to scientific world, whose main goal is to raise awareness around environmental issues. Alongside of the TRIPyr Consortium members, it is responsible for science outreach and communication in order to disclose the results of this project to society, in particular concerning circular economy and green chemistry. By making the development of TRIPyr accessible for schools, businesses and local communities, ECOCENE contributes to disseminating sustainable approaches.

Tying together research partners, companies, technological and communication associations, the TRIPyr project performs numerous actions ranging from efficient use of resources and adoption of environmental measures to citizenship awareness and stimulating economic growth.
